

NEW NCAA Junior College Transfer Rules

Beginning with student-athletes first enrolling in college in August 2012, there will be new Junior College Transfer Rules.

The changes include a financial aid, practice, and competition component and a financial aid and practice only component.

Financial Aid and Practice Only Component:

The current rules will be used to determine if they are eligible for aid and practice. An initial-eligibility status as a Qualifier or Non-Qualifier must be determined.

Competition Component:

Qualifier: Spend at least one full-time term at the JUCO, have a 2.50 GPA, have an average of 12 transferrable hours per semester, no more than 2 PE credit hours can be used (A 4-2-4 transfer must also graduate and one year elapse since departure from original 4-year school).

Non-Qualifier: Graduate from the JUCO, have a minimum of 48 transferrable hours with a 2.50 GPA, that includes 6 hours of English, 3 hours of Math and 3 hours of Natural and Physical Science, no more than 2 PE credit hours can be used and attend a JUCO for at least three full-time semesters.
